- 4. To encourage the development of meaningful interpersonal relationships among students, the staff and community.
- 5. To ensure that staff, students, and parents are afforded opportunities for participation in the development and evaluation of programs and policies.
- 6. To strive for maximum efficiency in the use of district resources to meet the goals and objectives of the various programs and services.

The Board shall periodically develop more specific goals as is deemed appropriate.

Because it is accountable to the residents of the district, the Board will maintain a program of accountability consisting of the following elements:

- 1. Clear statements of expectations and purpose as these relate to operations, programs, departments, positions.
- 2. Provision for staff, resources and support necessary to achieve stated expectations and purposes, subject to financial support by residents of the district.
- 3. Evaluation of operations, programs, instructions and services.
