

BOARD ELECTIONS

Candidates for Chairperson of the School Board will be nominated by voice vote at the next Board meeting after the annual school district meeting, an organizational meeting.

The Chairperson will then be elected by raised-hand vote at this meeting with a plurality vote needed to win. Voting will continue in the event of a failure of any candidate to achieve a greater vote than any other candidate, until a plurality vote is obtained.

Following the election of a Chairperson, the Vice-Chair will be elected by a raised-hand vote. A plurality vote will decide the outcome in case of the Vice-Chair, also.
