

TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROLS

Driving and parking on school property are privileges granted by the Board to persons who have reasons to be in the schools or on school property.

The school administration, in cooperation with local traffic authorities, will have a plan for accommodating the flow of traffic on school roadways, and traffic regulations.

The assignment of parking areas to staff, students and visitors to the school will be the responsibility of the school administration.

Because the Board desires to maintain the natural beauty of school grounds and surroundings, and to prevent damage to groundcover, plants and trees which may be caused by vehicles, the Board directs that signs be posted on all school property indicating that no motorized vehicles may be operated on school grounds except regular automobiles, motorcycles and trucks properly operated in designated areas. The signs will indicate that violators of traffic regulations will be prosecuted.

During hours that school is in session, including summer, only employees and those with official school district business are permitted to park in designated school parking lots.

From May 15th through September 15th, those wishing to park at Glen Lake School in order to access facilities outside of the school district, may do so only if they are a resident of the community of Goffstown. This parking restriction will be enforced by town ordinances. This restriction does not supersede any above restrictions.
