EVALUATION OF CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

The Superintendent will cause the evaluation of the instructional programs annually in accordance with local and state guidelines. S/he shall have the responsibility to report periodically to the School Board on the progress the District is making toward the attainment of its educational goals.

The purposes of evaluation of instruction are:

- 1. To determine educational needs and provide information for planning
- 2. To indicate instructional strengths and weaknesses
- 3. To evaluate the suitability and effectiveness of programs in terms of community requirements.
- 4. To show the relationship between achievement and the system's stated goals
- 5. To provide data for public information.
