STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE

Improper use of a motor vehicle on school grounds can result in suspension from school (in or out of school) for a period of time not to exceed five days. Driving a motor vehicle from school grounds during the school day without written authorization will be considered improper use of a motor vehicle and will be considered grounds for suspension.

Parking at the school is a privilege granted by the school and a privilege that can be withdrawn.

Prior to driving or parking on school grounds, students will be required to register motor vehicles in the main office and will be required to have a school sticker on the motor vehicle.
