## Principal's Corner

Hello families!

Hello! It's hard to believe January is almost over and we've passed the halfway point in the year! Kindergarten registration for next year begins on Monday. You don't need to register a student who is already here, as they will automatically be "rolled over" for next year. Preschool families, please watch for a form coming home with your student to indicate your preference for next year's session. You **MUST** complete this form on time in order to be considered for your preferred session. Please understand that we cannot guarantee a session. You should also be aware that most of our four-year-old classes are afternoon classes. We must balance student needs and our ability to provide services, as well.

Our preschool program is a side-by-side program where students with special needs attend alongside typically developing peer "role models" whose families pay tuition for them to attend. 3-year-old role model students attend three days per week (Tuesday through Thursday). 4-year-old role model students attend four days per week (Monday through Thursday). Tuition next year will be \$195 per month for 3-year-olds and \$260 per month for 4-year-olds. If you know anyone that is interested in sending a student to Glen Lake for preschool next year (who isn't already a student here) please tell them to call the school office right away to request an application. Applications are due back in the school office by February 23rd.

The School and Town Budget season continues. On **Monday, February 5th at 7 pm** the School Budget Deliberative Session will take place in the Goffstown High School theater. The Deliberative Session is your opportunity to learn about the proposed School District Budget for 2024-2025 and other school articles, ask questions, and make your voice heard, regarding the funding of your child's education. Changes to the proposed budget and monied warrant articles can be made that day so your attendance and participation is very important.



Glen Lake School Partnership (GLSP) will meet Wednesday evening, January 31st at 6 pm in the school office. All are welcome to attend! Come meet other parents and learn more about the ways GLSP supports our students!

# Nurse's Corner

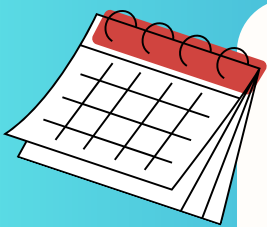
Greetings from the health office!

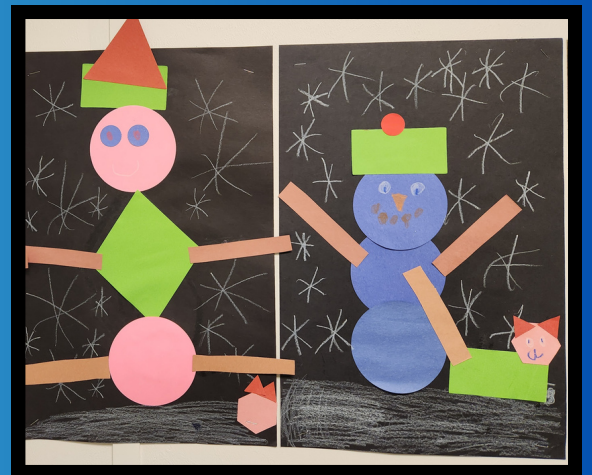
