Can you believe the first trimester is already coming to a close? **There is no school on Friday, December 8th** in order to provide time for 1st trimester Parent and Teacher Conferences. Please watch for an email Monday, November 27th letting you know how to sign up for a conference time online (more info below). Conferences will be held in person or, if you prefer, through video conferencing. When you book a time, please keep in mind that we ask that you are prompt for your appointment in order to help us maintain the meeting schedule. Conferences are fifteen minutes in length, so it is critical that they begin and end on time. We cannot extend conferences into another student's timeslot. 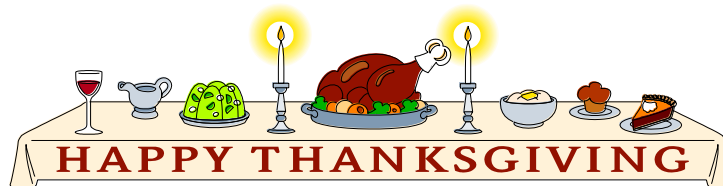

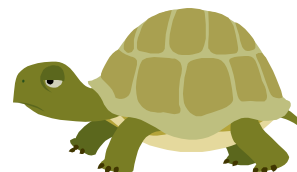

If your child is not feeling well for school, please call the front desk at 603-497-3550 to let us know they will be absent.

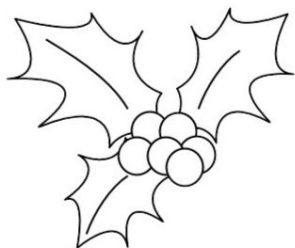

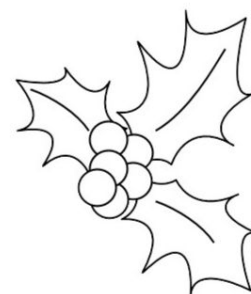


Destination Imagination for Glen Lake Kindergarten Students
